ACCESS ROAD IN BORWA TWEESPRUIT OPENED

Tweespruit- On the 26th September 2013 the Mayor of Mantsopa Local Municipality, Councilor S.D. Ntsepe and Mokheseng David Mokheseng Municipal Project Management Unit Technician, officially opened the access road that joins Borwa Township in Tweespruit.

The Mayor opened the road in the presence of jubilating and delighted members of the community of Borwa. The paved road, which covers 800 meters has been the initiative of EPW project. We are delighted to inform the Community that paving of the road was done in-house. The cost of the road has been R1, 4 million and has been able to employ 30 people.

There are other projects currently running in Mantsopa. The Municipality has made strides in eradicating buckets in Dipelaneng (Hobhouse) and Borwa (Tweespruit) as well as upgrading of water treatment works in both towns. In Manyatseng construction works is in progress on the paving of phase 1 of ring road.
