Scope of Services

The Scope of Services to be provided by the Consulting Engineer in terms of this Agreement includes the Services as described in Appendix A.

In the absence of a specific Scope of Services drawn up for this project, the Scope of Services will be as described in the latest published Guideline Scope of Services and Tariff of Fees for Persons Registered in terms of the Engineering Professions Act 2000 (Act No. 46 of 2000), Government Gazette No 28744 of 13 April 2006, as applicable at the time of signature of this Agreement, as per the Guidelines Scope of Works.

The normal services to be performed under this Agreement are: *

the design of the works; the compiling of the contract documentation; the administration; and the supervision over the contract.

According to details as stated in the letter of appointment and as per the approved project proposal.

CLAUSE 2.1.3 Design and Tender Stage

Add the following sub-clause:

(12) "Obtain all approvals, licenses and permits from government, regional and municipal authorities having jurisdiction over any aspect of the project."

CLAUSE 2.1.5 Construction Stage

Add the following sub-clause:

(19) "Provide the Technical Manager with a Schedule of Progress with target dates and expected expenditures before the end of each successive month over the full duration of the project."

CLAUSE 2.1.6 Targeted Procurement

It would be expected from the Consultant to audit the Contractor from time to time and ensure compliance according to the Contract Document.

CLAUSE 2.2.2 Construction Monitoring

For the provision of a construction monitoring service, as contemplated in clause 2.2.2, the consulting engineer is entitled to recover from the client

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- a) for monthly monitoring staff costs, the **total annual cost of employment** of such staff (as defined in clause 3.4(4)), divided by 12 and multiplied by one of the following:
 - Case 2:
 Where payment is only made for actual time on site and site allowances are paid separately:
 - 2, 0 times total cost of employment.

CLAUSE 2.2.3 Occupational Health and Safety Act, 1993 (Act No.85 of 1993)

The consulting engineer must arrange, formally and in writing, for the contractor to provide documentary evidence of compliance with all the requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Act, 1993 (Act No.85 of 1993).

Remuneration

The remuneration or method of determining the remuneration to be paid to the Consulting Engineer for providing the Services required in terms of this Agreement and for reimbursement for all expenses and costs incurred in performing the Services shall be in accordance with the latest published Guideline Scope of Services and Tariff of Fees for Persons Registered in terms of the Engineering Profession Act, 2000 (Act No. 46 of 2000) as applicable at the time of signature of this Form of Agreement, i.e. Government Gazette No. 28744 of 13 April 2006.

CLAUSE 3.5 Expenses and Cost

Sub clause 3.5.(2)(a)

a. When instructed by the Client to proceed to other centres, a motor transport allowance for the distance actually travelled at the rate per kilometre applicable as specified in (e)

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b. Reimbursement of the Consultant for the use of private motor transport by the Consultant's local Office Staff shall, however, be multiplying the kilometre distance as indicated in the following table by the applicable rate per kilometre, for the respective localities of the Works.

- c. Reimbursement of the Consultant for the provision of private motor transport for the purposes of Construction Monitoring Shall be as provided for in sub-clause (a) hereof.
- d. No travelling or subsistence allowances will be payable in respect of trips between Bloemfontein and any offices of the Consulting Engineer situated elsewhere other than in Bloemfontein except when qualifying in terms of Clause 2.2.1.
- e. The vehicle remuneration specified in a, b and c will be according to the newest published rates of the Dept of Public Works (Free State Province) and for the following type of vehicle:

No adjustment for vehicle type & extraordinary use is applicable.

CLAUSE 3.5(2)(b)(ii)

Amend the contents of this clause and replace with the following:

"Payment for time spent in travelling will be 50% of the normal claimable hourly rate may be claimed for all time spend by staff of the Consulting Engineer travelling, such time not exceeding eight hours per day."

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CLAUSE 3.5(2)(d) and (e)

All payments for reports, approved prints and documentation will be paid on the unit costs according to Dept of Public Works (Free State Province)
