Quotations are hereby invited from service providers to supply, deliver and branding 1000 Facial Cloth Masks for Mantsopa Local Municipality

## **Specifications:**

- Three (03) Layer Reusable Fabric (Cloth) Masks
- Out Layer: microfiber, 100% polyester (water repellent) to prevent wetting from external sources
- It should not restrict normal breathing
- Fabric should not allow liquids to move through
- Inner layer: polycot ton percale must be smooth, soft, pleasant feel against the skin
- The fabric should not irritate skin in any away or allow the build up of moisture or excessive heat between the skin and mask
- The fabric should have air permeability and should not restrict normal breathing
- Options: plain waves (light weight, low count) wrap knit polyester "mesh", spun, bond nonwovens
- Middle layer: Protection; should trap or stop particles microns and larger should not restrict air permeability or impede on the air permeability on the complete mask

- The filter should not shed fibers
- It should have a barrier efficiency of at least 75%
- Filter should not block > 25% of airflow through the fabric
- Must have a Mantsopa Local Municipality Logo embroidered on the left-hand side and have other message on the right "Stay Safe"
- Colour must be Black and Blue
- It must have ear loop black elastic bands
- The mask must cover a nose and chin and must not allow leakages
- It was be washable in warm water and iron friendly

NB: Sample must be provided before the final appointment

The bidder must indicate delivery period on the quotation

The bidder must fill in the MBD 4 Form

The bidder must fill in the MBD 6.2 Form (Local Content: Minimum must be 100%)
